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În temeiul art.7 alin.(3) pct.1) lit.b) din Codul aerian al Republicii Moldova nr.301/2017 și punctului 10 subpct.1) lit.b) din Regulamentul cu privire la organizarea și funcționarea Autorității Aeronautice Civile, aprobat prin Hotărârea Guvernului Republicii Moldova nr.133/2019, întru implementarea prevederilor Secțiunii a 2-a și Secțiunii a 3-a din Capitolul III din Regulamentul privind autorizarea zborurilor și utilizarea spațiului aerian de către aeronavele civile și de stat, aprobat prin Hotărârea Guvernului nr.870/2020,

ORDON:

- 1. Se aprobă Chestionarul pentru operatori aerieni străini (FOQ), conform anexei la prezentul ordin.
- **2.** Chestionarul se completează și se semnează de către operatorul aerian și autoritatea aeronautică civilă a statului operatorului aerian.
- **3.** Chestionarul se prezintă Autorității Aeronautice Civile a Republicii Moldova la prima depunere a documentelor necesare pentru obținerea autorizației pentru executarea zborurilor internaționale aferente operațiunilor de transport aerian comercial efectuate prin curse regulate și neregulate, cu aterizare/decolare pe/de pe teritoriul Republicii Moldova și în cazul modificării informatiei incluse în chestionar.
- **4.** Chestionarul se pune la dispoziția tuturor persoanelor interesate prin publicarea pe pagina web oficială <u>www.caa.md</u>, la compartimentul "Cadrul normativ/Alte acte normative" și în Publicația de Informare Aeronautică (Aeronautical Information Publication AIP) la Capitolul GEN 1.2.

CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA FOQ - Foreign Operators' Questionnaire

Foreword

Article 33 of the Convention on international civil aviation (Chicago Convention) of the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) states that certificates of airworthiness and certificates of competency and licenses issued or rendered valid by the contracting State in which the aircraft is registered shall be recognized as valid by the other contracting States, provided that the requirements under which such certificates or licenses were issued or rendered valid are equal to or above the minimum standards which may be established from time to time pursuant the Chicago Convention. Even though air operator certificates are not formally included yet in the mutual recognition statement, the same policy is currently applied by most ICAO contracting States.

Although implementation of the above provisions seems to solve the problem of the mutual recognition, the results of ICAO safety oversight audit programme show that several contracting States experienced difficulties to oversee their air operators in compliance with the Chicago Convention. Consequently, a decreasing confidence in foreign operators' safety standards may be experienced by States that are requested to grant authorizations for flights in their territories.

In order to maintain confidence in foreign aviation system, Civil Aviation Authority of the Republic of Moldova has developed the present "Foreign Operators' Questionnaire" to be completed by foreign air operators that are willing to perform commercial flights in the airspace of the Republic of Moldova. Accurate and prompt response should ease the authorization process. Endorsement for correctness of the provided information by the operator's State Civil Aviation Authority is required.

The following documents shall be enclosed to the questionnaire:

- 1. Copy of the current Air Operator Certificate or equivalent document;
- 2. Copy of the current Operations Specification or equivalent document showing the details and information concerning the operations capabilities:
 - a) Operator's fleet (type, model, registration marks);
 - b) Area and type of operations;
 - c) Special Approvals (LVO, RNAV, RVSM, ETOPS, MNPS, Transport of Dangerous Goods, etc.);
- 3. Copy of any operator's technical or operational documentation, or part thereof, that is deemed useful to further detail the information and data provided in the questionnaire.
