ORDER no. 04/GEN

of 1 February 2017

On recognition of maintenance organizations certified in accordance with Annex II (Part 145) of the Commission Regulation (EU) No 1321/2014 of 26 November 2014

In accordance with article 5, paragraph (3), e)-f) of the Civil aviation law no. 1237-XIII of 09.07.1997 and point 7, paragraphs 5)-6) of the Regulation on organization and functioning of the Civil Aviation Authority approved by the Government Decision of the Republic of Moldova no. 645 of 07.08.2014, taking into account provisions of point 7.3 of the Working arrangements concluded between the European Aviation Safety Agency and the Civil Aviation Authority of the Republic of Moldova on 28.11.2014, based on the conclusions of the comparative analysis between the national regulatory framework applicable to recognition of the maintenance organizations and the Commission Regulation (EU) no.1321/2014 of 26 November 2014, I hereby

ORDER:

- 1. Recognition, as providers of maintenance services of the aircraft registered in the Aviation register of the Republic of Moldova, of aircraft maintenance organizations certified in accordance with Commission Regulation (EU) no.1321/2014 of 26 November 2014 on the continuing airworthiness of aircraft and aeronautical products, parts and appliances, and on the approval of organizations and personnel involved in these tasks.
- 2. For recognition by the Civil Aviation Authority of the maintenance organizations according to point 1 of this Order, owners/air operators of the aircraft registered in the Aviation register of the Republic of Moldova shall assure:
 - a) provision of a copy of the Maintenance Organization Exposition (MOE) to the Civil Aviation Authority;
 - b) if necessary, free access of the Civil Aviation Authority inspectors to the facilities of the maintenance organizations for the purpose of checking compliance with procedures and standards and to investigate specific problems;
 - c) reporting to the Civil Aviation Authority of the cases when the aircraft registered in the Aviation register of the Republic of Moldova is not airworthy.
- 3. Certificates (forms) issued by the maintenance organizations recognized by the Civil Aviation Authority according to point 1 of this Order are considered to be equivalent to those established by the applicable regulatory framework of the Republic of Moldova.

- 4. Release to service statements issued by the maintenance organizations recognized by the Civil Aviation Authority according to point 1 of this Order shall be amended in order to make reference to this Order and to replace the reference "Part 145" with "National requirements of the Republic of Moldova".
- 5. The Order shall enter into force on the date it is published in the Official Journal of the Republic of Moldova.
